- Budgetary reasons pushed for the 6 period vs 7 period day
 -strategic planning also involved in the decision of not doing
 the block days straight 6 periods instead of modified block
 days voted in by the staff. He felt like seeing teachers everyday
 was important and training involved in teaching 90 minutes is
 difficult. Students' attention spans were also considered in the
 decision.
